Pastor's Ponderings

Gus Suarez, an executive director for the Northwest Convention, shares his insight related to "loving his church." Having a home church is as important for my family and me as having a home. My church is not perfect and one of the reasons is that I am part of it. But I love my church and I love my pastor, so I want to do everything I can to be supportive and together reach a lost world with the gospel of our Lord. Let me share some ways we can be a help to our church.

Be faithful to attend and participate. Come to worship and actively participate in the worship experience, expecting God to do great things. Remember that we serve a risen Christ. You can make a difference in the attitude of your church. Let it begin with you.

Support your pastor and the church staff. My church takes care of my pastor financially, but he is not my hired servant. I need to be part of the overall ministries of the church so that my pastor may have more time to study God's Word. I know my pastor has a passion for evangelism, but I need to help out and do my part as well.

Pray for your church leadership. It is important to pray for my pastor and for the entire pastoral staff. Building a relationship with my pastors will enable me to know better how to pray and minister to them.

Practice stewardship.

Be part of the solution. No church is perfect. I need to be part of the solution and not the problem.
